Born in California, Elise spent many of her summers in New Jersey and Mexico. As a pre-teen, she moved to Utah, but continued as a volunteer building homes in Mexico for those in need. While there, she started working with special needs adults and children. This commitment to special needs individuals continued into her schooling in Utah, where she was given permission as a part of her curriculum to work with special needs individuals.

In 2015, Elise moved to Michigan where she continued to work with special needs individuals. She took on two additional responsibilities: in-home health care and working with women in high conflict circumstances. In all of her employment experiences, helping to promote effective communication has been at the forefront, which is a natural qualification for being an effective mediator.

Northern Community Mediation is a non-profit organization that provides an alternative means of resolving conflict. Trained mediators, who meet with the parties involved in a dispute, facilitate the process so that the individuals themselves can resolve the conflict
