### REMINDER

If an agreement is reached in a general civil case, it is imperative that one of the following statements is included in that agreement.

NAME OF INDIVIDUAL (generally the plaintiff or the plaintiff’s attorney) will file the dismissal within 21 days from the date of this mediation, which would be SPECIFY DATE AND TIME at the latest.

or

NAME OF INDIVIDUAL (generally the plaintiff or the plaintiff’s attorney) will file the judgment either by articulating the details of the agreement on the judgment or by attaching a copy of the signed, NCM agreement within 21 days from the date of this mediation, which would be SPECIFY DATE AND TIME at the latest.
